Who can attend the BCOC AGM?

The AGM is open to all members of the Banbury & District Chamber of Commerce. It is an opportunity to reflect on the Chamber's performance, elect key officers, and contribute to our future direction.

When is the AGM held?

Our Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held in June each year. The 2026 AGM took place on Wednesday, 24 June, at Whately Hall Hotel, and the next meeting is scheduled for June 2027 (date and venue to be confirmed).

What is required for the AGM to go ahead?

For the meeting to be quorate, at least 80% of the Board, including the Chair and the Financial Director, must be present.

How can I participate in voting at the AGM?

Votes can be cast in person at the AGM or submitted in advance by emailing bcoc@banburychamber.co.uk. Details of voting matters are shared with members ahead of the meeting.

How do I apply for a position on the BCOC Board?

Members interested in joining the Board or standing for a specific role can view current opportunities and express their interest via our website.

Is the AGM a public or private meeting?

The AGM is a member-only business meeting. However, the minutes and financial accounts are available on our website and promoted in our member newsletter after the event.

Is there a social element to the AGM?

Yes — while the AGM itself is business-focused, we follow it with a social event in aid of one of our charitable member organisations. This year, our Charity Quiz raised £527.40 for Banbury Museum.
